Travelling to the city from Station Pier on public transport

Your ship arrives at Station Pier in Port Melbourne, six kilometres from the city centre. To travel into the city, catch a bus or tram using a myki, Melbourne's reusable travel card.

City/Port Melbourne (quickest journey)

Bus Route 109 runs from Station Pier to Stop 115 – Casino/Southbank in the city, on most cruise ship days, from 8am to 5pm. This is the quickest way to reach the city centre. If you're returning to Station Pier, you'll need to show your cruise ship passenger pass to security for inspection.

Buses don't run on turnaround visits – when ships begin or end a cruise in Melbourne – due to restrictions on Station Pier. Trams run as usual.

Port Melbourne/Box Hill

Tram Route 109 leaves from stop 129 – Beacon Cove/Light Rail, at the end of Station Pier. It travels through Port Melbourne and along Collins Street, in the heart of the city.



myki is your ticket to travel on trains, trams and buses in Melbourne.

Tickets

To start travelling, simply buy a myki Explorer, a myki card or get setup with Mobile myki, then be sure to touch on and off when travelling on trains, trams or buses.

myki Explorer

Enjoy a ready-to-use myki card with one day's unlimited travel on public transport in Melbourne. Your pack also includes handy maps and access to discounts for lots of great visitor experiences. If you want to keep travelling, just top up your myki. Buy yours from the myki customer service desk in the cruise ship terminal at Station Pier – AUD \$16 full fare, AUD \$8 concession or child.

Alternatively, you can buy a myki and top up at the myki customer service desk in the cruise ship terminal at Station Pier. As a guide, \$10 will get you around Melbourne for a day, with a little change.

Mobile myki

If you've got an Android phone, you can opt for a digital myki. To get started with Mobile myki;

1. Download Google Pay™
2. Follow the instructions within Google Pay™ to set up your payment card
3. Go to Passes. Tap the blue + Pass button and select Public transport. Choose myki
4. Choose myki Money
5. Choose your fare product: Full fare, Child or General concession
6. Finish the transaction and you're ready to travel!

Free tram travel

You don't need a myki if you're only travelling in the city's Free Tram Zone or on the historic City Circle Tram, Route 35. Note that Station Pier is outside of the Free Tram Zone.
